Following is a chart of horizontal lines with four words on each line, one in each column. On each line, put the number 4 next to the word that best describes you in that line. Then put a 3 next to the word that describes you next best, a 2 by the third—best word, and a 1 by the word that least describes you. On each horizontal line of words you will then have one 4, one 3, one2, and one 1. Do not put more than one of any number on any horizontal line of words.

For example, my choice for the first line of words would be as follows: Likes Having Authority _3 Enthusiastic _4 Sensitive Feelings 2 Likes Instructions 1
